

BIRD WATCHING

Flowers are blossoming, birds are chirping, and summer is in the air! For this activity, we are going to be building our own binoculars to go bird watching!



MATERIALS

- 2 Toilet Paper Rolls
- Single Hole Punch
- Yarn
- Scissors
- Tape (Masking or Scotch)
- Construction Paper
- Coloring Tools
- Embellishments
- Bird Watching Booklet (Included)

DIRECTIONS

Begin by using the hole punch to create one hole in each tube towards the top for the string. Next, secure the 2 toilet paper rolls together with tape and ensuring the holes are on the outside.

Next, knot each end of the yarn through the holes to create a strap. Finally, wrap construction paper around the tubes and decorate your binoculars! You can use crayons, markers, stickers, and more to make them unique!

Now that your binoculars are ready, peer out a window or go on a nature walk to observe these birds in their natural environment! Use the booklet to identify birds that are found on Martha's Vineyard. If you don't live on MV, use a blank template to draw your own finds!
